### **IMPOUNDED VEHICLES TO BE COLLECTED OR IT WILL BE DISPOSED OF** *Friday 1 July 2022 is the deadline*

Mr. Robison Thekiso, acting as Head of the Department of Police, Roads and Transport (DPRT), in terms of section 38 (1) (c) (i) of the Public Finance Management Act 1999, hereby gives notice to all owners whose vehicles have been impounded by the Free State Provincial Government for a period exceeding 12 months, to come collect their vehicles.

The vehicles at stake are stored at various driving licence and testing centres (DLTCs) of the DPRT and can be picked up after payment of the costs owed to the Free State Provincial Government.

Should owners fail to fetch the vehicles by 12:00 on Friday 1 July 2022, the Provincial Government will dispose of the said vehicles to recoup the costs involved.

Any person may inspect the list of vehicles concerned at any relevant Free State DLTC during office hours (07:30 – 16:00 on weekdays). A list is also available on the DPRT's website at <http://www.policeroadtransport.fs.gov.za/> under 'PUBLIC NOTICES'.
